Committee Descriptions

Finance Committee provides financial oversight for the church and its various programs and ministries.

Personnel Committee administers all personnel policies and procedures, including job descriptions, salaries, benefits, and performance evaluation.

Properties Committee ensures the church is an attractive and well-kept property in the community and makes recommendations concerning major repairs and improvements.

Stewardship Committee develops and implements a program of education in Christian stewardship of possessions, time, and talents for the entire church.

Missions Committee integrates missions in the life of the church through exposition, example, and experience.

Benevolence Committee, based on James 2:14-16, reviews requests from Cliff Temple members in need of temporary assistance for essential living expenses to determine how funds and services are distributed.

Scholarship Committee administers and awards scholarships to eligible applicants.

Servant Selection Committee solicits recommendations from staff and church members for best-qualified church members as lay leaders and presents a recommendation for church approval.

Mission Oak Cliff Committee assists MOC staff in directing the ministry and future planning.
